Need-based bursaries



- Main eligibility criteria : Have an unexpected need for financial assistance
- Students who have adequate cumulative GPA
- One online form for all need-based and encouragement bursaries
- Join all the required documents

Encouragement bursaries



- Main eligibility criteria : Effort and perseverance
- One online form for all Need-based and encouragement bursaries
- Join all the required documents
- Varity of criteria check the scholarship directory of each bursaries

Merit-based Scholarships



- Main eligibility criteria : Excellent academic record (GPA from about 3,7)
- One online form for all Merit-based scholarships
- Provide requested documents

Some scholarships could be attributed automatically without any application.



Student research scholarships



- Main eligibility criteria : To present a well-developed research project in conformity with the requirements
- Possess a good academic record
- Complete one form per competition
- Provide required documents and meet all criteria
- The project should not be fully subsidized
- For information: MSc / PhD

Tips on the application process

1. Prepare your application in advance

Read all the documentation.

Take into account all admission and evaluation criteria.

Pay attention to what information is required and which documents you have to provide.

If you need to provide a CV, consult the HEC handbook.

2. Make sure to present a complete and thorough application

Be specific, provide concrete facts and examples.

Recommendation letters must include information on: academic excellence, leadership, involvement, research skills, etc.

Use plain, concise and accurate language in your research project summary or when describing your financial situation.

3. Submit your application on time

Ensure that you submit all the required documents

Have somebody proofreading your application before submitting it.

Check your spelling and syntax.
