The BBA International Pathway is a minimum four-year management program

- The preparatory and first year of studies are completed at Chongqing Technology and Business University in China.
- Years 2 and 3 are completed at HEC Montréal in Canada.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE INTERNATIONAL PATHWAY

- An opportunity to gain hands-on management experience and build a network of business contacts through for-credit internships in local businesses and project courses.
- A generalist approach that focuses heavily on the fundamentals and functions of management, allowing each student to develop strong analytical, synthesis and problem-solving skills, and that incorporates the latest management theories.
- Cross-disciplinary skills development, whereby students learn about ethics relating to business issues and build their skills in the areas of teamwork, creativity, autonomy, and leadership.
- Intensive use of new information technologies, giving each student the chance to adopt and use these tools on a daily basis in their studies, work and communications.

HEC MONTRÉAL OFFERS

- Access to 314 faculty members, 50% of whom are international professors.
- A multilingual approach unique to North America with French immersion.
- A dedicated team to support students during the various stages of the program (e.g., online registration at HEC Montréal, student visa procedures, settling in Montreal, social and academic integration, and course tutoring).
- The Career Management Service will accompany students from the moment they arrive at HEC Montréal. It will help them implement their job search strategy, even after they graduate.

The program promotes leadership and pushes each student to excel and flourish as a future manager by gaining an international experience.

Students begin studying in China before coming to Canada, allowing them to save on tuition and living expenses for the first two years.

Students then conduct their study in Montreal **for a minimum of two years** of BBA pathway.

Students begin discovering North American teaching methods (e.g. case studies, flipped classrooms, and teamwork) from the start of their program by taking a few courses taught by HEC Montréal professors at CTBU.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- High school diploma: formally registered bachelor students of CTBU (English scored 100 and above out of 150 in College Entrance Exam in China, excluding majoring in art and physical education).
- Intermediate-advanced proficiency in English: IELTS 5.5-6.5, TOEFL 72-94, TOEIC 601-780, AP 4, SAT 700, LinguaSkill 160-179.

ADDITIONAL CRITERIA FOR BILLINGUAL STREAM

Get the International French Test (IFT) at a score of 850 or higher
 Mention initiale: Applicants to HEC Montréal must pass the International French Test
 (IFT) before being admitted to a program at a score of 850 or higher

HEC MONTREAL Courses fees: 1 course include

- 1 course included in your program -3 credits
- 1 to 2 courses in addition to the Business French Summer School: 1 875 CAD/course -9 730 ¥/course

The HEC Montréal degree is a Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) issued by HEC Montréal and Université de Montréal.

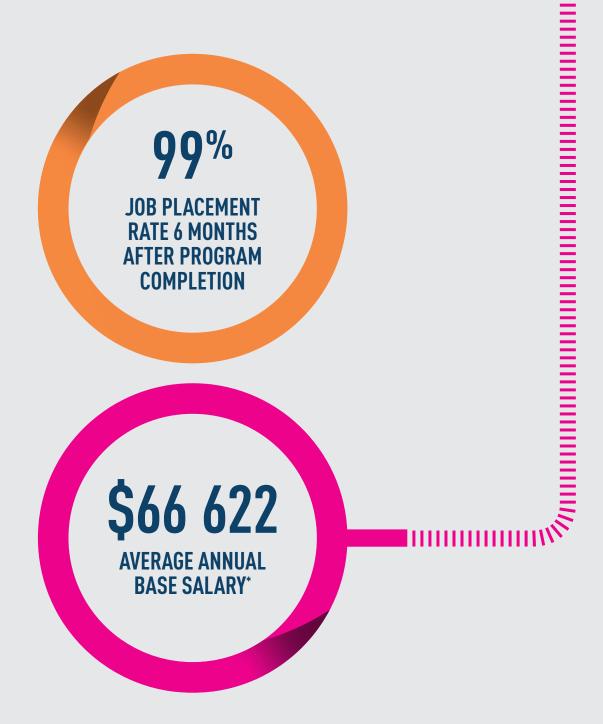

In 2009, CTBU and HEC Montréal started to communicate for cooperation in Chongqing, China. After three years of preparation, the joint-degree program began to recruit students in September 2012. The program is run by 2+2 mode and aims to cultivate trilingual (Chinese, English and French) business talents with cross-cultural knowledge. Therefore, it got nickname "2+2 Elite Program".
